



## Travelling Options: Annie's Dogs

---

### OBEDIENCE

---

I am happy to travel to you. The following needs to occur:

1. You are able to get a group of 10 or more people to join the course.
2. You can recommend an outdoor training facility (usually an enclosed open space i.e. outdoor netball courts are fine. If in summer or winter, we will need an area that is undercover to prevent heat issues and rain issues). I am happy to make arrangements with the organization, however, I will need recommendations by locals as I am unlikely to know the area.
3. Cost is higher due to my travel costs and time investment. They are as follows:
  - WITHIN 30 minutes of Ararat: \$660pp.
  - WITHIN an hour and a half of Ararat: \$800pp.
  - MORE than 2 hours from Ararat: \$1000pp.
4. It's a 3 day course, 9am – 12pm as a rough guide. Sometimes we don't finish until closer to 1pm. It just depends on the dogs.
5. You are welcome to train two dogs. You will need two people (one with each dog) for this to be possible. The cost is as above x 2. This is because I will need to spend equal time with you as with every other participant, therefore your two dogs will be the equivalent of two equal spaces. I do recommend that you don't actually need to train two dogs however, as this course teaches you everything you need to know to go home and teach your second dog without needing my help. So, if money is tight, do know this is an option.

### THERAPY and ASSISTANCE DOG

---

I am happy to travel to you. The following needs to occur:

1. You are able to get a group of 10 or more people to join the course.
2. You can recommend an outdoor training facility (usually an enclosed open space i.e. outdoor netball courts is fine. If in summer or winter, we will need an area that is undercover to prevent heat issues and rain issues). I am happy to make arrangements with the organization, however, I will need recommendations as I am unlikely to know the area.
3. You can recommend an indoor hall. This will be for our theory component in the afternoons. Preferably with heating and cooling. I am happy to make arrangements with the facility, however I will need recommendations as I am unlikely to know the area. Ideally this facility would be within close proximity to our morning training area.
4. You can recommend public organizations to visit. These usually include nursing homes, hospitals, school holiday programs etc. Ideally these will be in semi-close proximity to our other facilities. Again, I am happy to make contact with the facilities.
5. Cost is higher due to my travel costs and time investment. They are as follows:
  - WITHIN 30 minutes of Ararat: \$1860pp.
  - WITHIN Victoria: \$2000pp.
  - OUTSIDE of Victoria: \$2200pp.
6. It's a 5 day course, 9am – 3pm as a rough guide. Sometimes we don't finish until closer to 3pm. It depends on how the dogs are going.
